We have a fabulous fun show planned with 6 classes to choose from and toys and food are allowed in the ring all day. (Please try not to use food that breaks up all over the floor) Also, if weather permitting we will have a "Have-a-Go" Hoopers ring outside all day (£1/per 2 runs) proceeds to a local Wildlife Fund.

Classes are £8 per class as follows:-

Class 1 - Starters/Novice (Freestyle or Heelwork)

This is for you to do your own freestyle or heelwork routine. Max time allowed as per KC ie: Starters 2.5mins, Novice 3.5mins. **PLEASE STATE WHAT LEVEL YOU CURRENTLY WORK AT**, this is important as there will be rosettes/prizes for 1st to 3rd at each level.

Class 2 - Intermediate/Advanced (Freestyle or Heelwork)

This is for you to do your own freestyle or heelwork routine. Max time allowed as per KC ie: Intermediate 3.5mins, Advanced 4.0mins. **PLEASE STATE WHAT LEVEL YOU CURRENTLY WORK AT**, this is important as there will be rosettes/prizes for 1st to 3rd at each level.

Class 3 - U/12's Freestyle or Heelwork. (This class has kindly been sponsored by Carol Mortimer)

This is for you to do your own freestyle or heelwork routine - max time allowed is 2.5mins. You do not have to be a member of the YKC to enter.

Class 4 - Busking (time allowed 3mins)

Pete the DJ will pick the music for you to busk away to

Class 5 - Burglar Bill (time allowed 3.5mins)

A criminal theme - either in the title of the music or in the story of the routine...

Class 6 - Disney (time allowed 3.5mins)

Lots of choice here, any Disney theme..

All classes will be judged according to teamwork and entertainment. There will be an extra half point for costumes. Judges can confer with each other.

Rosettes and prizes for all classes.

Participating:

1. Dogs do not have to be registered with the Kennel Club to participate, however they must be over **ten months** on the day of the show. Dogs under 18 months on the day of the show ***must not*** perform excessive freestyle moves and judges reserve the right to stop a routine if the dog is performing moves inappropriate to its age.
2. No bitch in season is allowed at the venue.
3. Handlers are responsible for ensuring that their dog is healthy and fit to participate.
4. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling in the precincts of the show.
5. No moves or handling which may cause injury to the dog or banned moves are allowed.
6. All dogs must be under control within in the precincts of the show at all times.
7. Anyone not adhering to the above rules will be asked to leave the venue.

Running orders will be emailed so please ensure we can read your email address on the entry form.

CD's only please, marked with correct track

If time allows, there will be half an hour lunch break when dogs may be allowed in the ring, again dependant upon the weather and ground conditions.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE RING SIZE IS APPROX 10m x 12m so you may need to take this into account when choreographing your routine. The ring is carpetted

Catering:

There will be a catering van on site for breakfasts, lunches and refreshments.

Venue:

The venue is purpose built for canine activities and is surrounded by extensive woodland walks.

Please however, keep your dog(s) on lead around the car-parking and camping areas. There is a fully fenced exercise area where you can let your dog(s) off the lead and of course plenty of woodland walks.
